

Personal, Social, Health and Economics within a STEM context at the NSETC:

Science, technology, engineering and maths, as well as business and enterprise are the threads which run through the North Somerset Enterprise & Technology College. These focus areas provide a multitude of opportunities for students to develop their Personal, social, health and economic awareness, developing a well-rounded individual for life after NSETC .

Context

PSHE is delivered through two main programs for all learners. Thought provoking assemblies once a week lead with a theme of the week, which is linked, to a spiritual message. One-hour weekly lesson explores the program of study in association with, (PSHE Association) with a 2-year key stage program linking the core theme, whilst giving a clear focus within each year.

Overview

KS4 Year 10

One Hour Lesson per week within Curriculum time.

One Assembly per week (15 Minutes)

Four Tutor time themed session per week AM registration (15 minutes)

KS4 Year 11

One Hour Lesson per week within Curriculum time.

One Hour independent lesson per week within Curriculum time (used for external speakers/2nd hour for greater depth of topic where planned. Along with “Life Skills”

One Assembly per week (15 Minutes)

Four Tutor themed sessions per week AM registration (15 minutes)

KS5 Year 12/13

- Tutorial – 15 mins per day
- Assembly every Wednesday
- PSHCE – via tutorial and four collapsed day provision.
- Personal development,
- Citizenship and careers/ progression routes.
- Careers seminars from both employer and universities.

There is a focus on employability at NSETC and we work with local employers to give students first hand experiences to equip them for the future. A wide range of sectors visits the school over the key stage to support students and advise on next steps.
